FreedomVOICE Launches *FaxFreedom*, Toll-Free Service For Sending, Receiving and Managing Faxes on Any Computer

Users access and manage their faxes using the FaxFreedom WebLINK Internet Control Panel. Incoming faxes include date received and caller/sender identification. Other features include unlimited fax storage capacity, the ability to archive important faxes on individual computers for quick retrieval, call back and pager notification when faxes arrive, e-mail delivery of faxes, the ability to have a new toll-free number or transfer an existing number, a feature for taking personal notes on sent faxes for future reference and another feature for naming sent faxes for easier organization. Users can also generate detailed reports on received or sent faxes by multiple criteria.

The monthly FaxFreedom service costs \$9.95 and includes 100 minutes of free usage each month. Rates are as low as 4.5 cents per minute beyond the 100 minutes.
